1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the order dated 13.02.2026 (Annexure P-10) whereby, the services of the petitioner have been discontinued with immediate effect.

2. The contention raised by the petitioner in the present writ petition is that the impugned order vide which the service of the petitioner has been discontinued, was passed without giving any notice or opportunity of hearing, as such, the impugned order dated 13.02.2026 (Annexure P-10) is bad in law and is liable to be set-aside.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. A.K.Goel, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and Mr. Virender Gill, Advocate for Mr. Jasbir Mor, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.4.

5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 submits that the University has taken a decision to withdraw the impugned

order dated 13.02.2026 (Annexure P-10) with liberty to pass a fresh order after hearing the petitioner in accordance with law.

6. In view of the statement of the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to respondents No.1 to 3, as prayed for.

7. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
