1. Both the petitions, the details of which are mentioned in the heading, involve common point of law and common set of facts, hence, they are being dealt together. For the sake of convenience, the facts are being taken from CWP No.6541 of 2026.

2. The present petition has been filed seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 5 for constitution of Delimitation Board for the purpose of carrying out delimitation/readjustment of wards of Municipal Council, Dina

Nagar, District Gurdaspur as required under Rule 3 of the Delimitation of Wards of Municipalities Rules, 1972.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the grievance raised, the petitioner will file a representation with the respondent-State and the respondent-State be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On an advance copy being served upon the respondents, Mr. Jastej Singh, the learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 4, whereas Mr. Sarthak Soni, Advocate for Mr. Sanjeev Soni, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.5.

6. The learned counsel for respondents submits that in case, any such representation is made by the petitioner, the same will be considered in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of the representation. In case, it is found feasible to accept the request of the petitioner, the same will be accepted; otherwise due reasons for not accepting the claim will be recorded in the speaking order and conveyed to the petitioner.

7. In view of the above, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits, that both the petitions may kindly be disposed of having not been pressed any further with liberty to file a representation.

8. Ordered accordingly.

9. Pending application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
