1. In the present writ petition, the petitioners are praying for issuance of directions to the respondents to fix the pay and grant the revised pay scale to the petitioners w.e.f. 01.01.2006, consequent upon, the pay revision carried out by the 5th Pay Commission.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties are *ad idem* that the dispute being *inter se* the Management and the employees-petitioners, so the present petition may be transferred to First Additional District and Sessions Judge, Chandigarh, for adjudication.

3. It is brought to the notice of this Court that vide Notification

Education, Chandigarh Administration, wherein, the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh has authorized the First Additional District and Sessions Judge, Chandigarh to hear the appeals arising out of the disputes between Management and Staff of Recognized Private Schools (aided/un-aided), Private Colleges and Private Universities in U.T Chandigarh for intermediate period till the Specialized Tribunal is constituted on permanent basis.

4. In view of the above and without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is ordered to be relegated to First Additional District and Sessions Judge, Chandigarh, in light of the Notification dated 20.05.2013, having the jurisdiction. Parties are directed to appear before it on 11.05.2026 at 10:00 a.m.
5. Registry is directed to send the record of this case to First Additional District and Sessions Judge, Chandigarh forthwith.
6. The present writ petition is disposed of in the abovesaid terms.
7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
