HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

Petition herein is, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the official respondents to re-issue passport to the petitioner by mentioning the correct Date of Birth as 27.01.1989.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the judgment of this Court in ***CWP No.10188 of 2025*** titled as ***“Ajay Bhola Vs. Union of India and others”***, decided on 12.12.2025.

3. At this stage, learned counsel appearing for the respondents submits that as on date, no application for re-issuance of passport filed by

the petitioner is pending with the passport authorities. He further submits that in case the petitioner submits a fresh application for re-issuance of passport with the correct Date of Birth as '27.01.1989', duly supported by all relevant information/documents, the same shall be considered by the concerned passport authorities, in accordance with law, as well as in the light of the judgment of this Court in *Ajay Bhola's case (supra)*, and a final decision thereupon shall be taken within a period of eight weeks from the date of submission of such application, after affording due opportunity of hearing to all concerned parties and/or after seeking requisite information/clarification and/or documents from the petitioner, if the need so arises.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel appearing for the respondents, no further orders are required to be passed in the present writ petition and the same is, accordingly, disposed of.

4.1 It goes without saying that in case any information/clarification and/or document is required from the petitioner, the passport authority may requisition the same by way of a written communication.

5. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
