The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the respondent Nos.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent Nos.5 and 6 who are giving regular threats to the life of the petitioner on account of a property dispute for which the FIR No.188 dated 01.10.2015 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 307, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, P.S. Zira, Ferozepur already stands registered.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the life and liberty of the petitioner be protected at the hands of respondent Nos.5 and 6 as the dispute pertains to a property for which an FIR No.188 dated 01.10.2015 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 307, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, P.S. Zira, Ferozepur stands registered.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel contends that initially a cancellation report was submitted but the matter has been sent for further investigation which shall be concluded within a period of four weeks. He contends that the petitioner does not require any protection as nothing untoward has taken place for the last almost 10 years.

Heard.

In view of the contentions raised, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to the SSP, Moga to supervise the further investigation and only then submit the final report before the Court.
