1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner for directions to the respondents No.1 to 4 to take action upon the complaint No.13237038250949 dated 04.12.2025 (Annexure P-1) and complaint No.1791 email dated 04.12.2025 Annexure P-2.

2. The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the petitioner has filed representations (Annexures P-1 & P-2) before the respondent No.2-the Director General of Police, Haryana. The learned counsel prays for directions to the respondent No.2 to decide the abovementioned representations within the stipulated time.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Since advance notice has already been served upon the State,

Mr. Ramender Singh Chauhan, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of

respondents-State. Hence, the service of notice upon the State is hereby dispensed with.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a direction for deciding the representations of the petitioner (Annexures P-1 & P-2) be given to the respondent No.2 and that the instant petition be disposed of accordingly.

6. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2-the Director General of Police, Haryana or, on assignment by him, by any other police officer not below the rank of the Superintendent of Police to decide the representations of the petitioner (Annexure P-1 & P-2), by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of instant order. It is however clarified that no finding is being returned by this Court, with regard to merits of the contents of representations. The respondent No.2 shall be at liberty to make an independent assessment with regard to contents of representations of the petitioner and take an independent decision at his own level.
