1. On 08.04.2021, the following order was passed:

“Heard through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that transfer order dated 01.04.2021, transferring the petitioner from District Police Gurugram to 1st Battalion HAP, Ambala City, is not in consonance with Rules 12.1(4) as well as 14.15 and 14.16 of the Punjab Police Rules, 1934 since the petitioner has been transferred out of his range. He would further contend that the petitioner has not been relieved as of date from his current place of posting.
