1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the order dated 27.04.1999 (Annexure P-11) vide which the claim of petitioner for grant of two advance increments on acquiring a Post-Graduate qualification, has been rejected.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that a similar issue has already been decided by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court in **CWP No.2840 of 2000, titled as 'Tarsem Lal Vs. State of Punjab and others', decided on 20.09.2024.**

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondents to consider the claim of petitioner, in



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light of the judgment passed by this Court in **Tarsem Lal's** case (*supra*).

4. Learned State counsel does not object to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner in light of the judgment passed by this Court in **Tarsem Lal's** case (*supra*), in accordance with law, within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand(s) disposed of accordingly.
