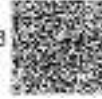

1. The substantive prayer made in the instant petition reads thus:

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that the present Petition may kindly be allowed by quashing the complaint titled Sohan Lal Sarpanch Vs. Subhkarman Singh and Anr.’ vide Complaint No. CIS SC No. 0116 of 2022, CNR No. PBH001-002835-2022, dated 02.05.2022 & under Section 3 of the Schedule Castes Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (Annexure P-1) alongwith its subsequent proceedings, the present complaint has been filed out of ill will after 39 months of delay from the alleged occurrence 21.01.2019 and the same complaint dated is due to earlier 25.11.2019 filed by Amanpreet Kaur daughter of Kuldeep Singh (appellant no. 2) and sister of Shubhkarman Singh (appellant no.1) complainant/ respondent against present no. 2-Sohan Lal Sarpanch and other co-accused, who have already been summoned vide summoning order dated 04.05.2022 is attached as Annexure P-2.”

2. During the course of hearing, the parties were referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court. A settlement (terms whereof have been reduced into writing vide settlement agreement dated 05.02.2026) has been entered into between the parties.
3. In view thereof, the petition in hand is disposed of, in terms of the settlement agreement dated 05.02.2026.
4. Needless to say that the parties shall remain bound by the terms of above said settlement agreement. Liberty is reserved in favour of the either party(s) to seek recall of this order on showing sufficient cause.
