The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking direction to the respondents to decide the representation-cum-application dated 11.02.2025 (Annexure P-5) and 16.01.2026 (Annexure P-6). Further a prayer has been made to direct the respondents to consider the claim for the petitioner for compassionate appointment.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to the respondent/State to decide the representation-cum-application dated 11.02.2025 (Annexure P-5) and 16.01.2026 (Annexure P-6).

3. In the light of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, respondent No.1–The General Manager-1, State Bank of India, is directed to decide the representation-cum-application dated 11.02.2025 (Annexure P-5) and 16.01.2026 (Annexure P-6) after providing opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from today. A copy of the said speaking order shall be supplied to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

4. The petition in the aforesaid terms stands disposed off.
