SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (Oral):

The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the illegal, arbitrary and discriminatory action of the respondents in withholding and denying Dearness Allowance (DA) and Leave Travel Concession (LTC)/one month salary in lieu thereof to the petitioners, in violation of the Outsourcing Policy dated 06.04.2015 (Annexure P-2) as amended on dated 11.09.2017 (Annexure P-3), Government Notifications dated 21.04.2010 (Annexure P-5) and dated 14.02.2023 (Annexure P-6), judgment dated 22.04.2025 (Annexure P-16), and dated 30.01.2026 (Annexure P-17) passed by this Court and judgment dated 22.08.2025 (Annexure P-18) passed by the Hon'ble Apex Court, and in disregard of binding judicial precedents declared under Article 141 of the Constitution of India and with a further prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release and grant



Dearness Allowance (DA) along with arrears and interest, and to extend Leave Travel Concession (LTC)/one month salary in lieu thereof with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to the respondent/State to decide the legal notice cum representation dated 20.01.2026 (Annexures P-20).

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Deepak Balyan, Addl. A.G., Haryana, having served with an advance copy of the petition, has put in appearance on behalf of respondents/State and assures the Court that the above-said representation will be decided within time bound manner.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, respondent No.2-Secretary Haryana Public Service Commission, Bays 1-10, Block-B, Sector-4 Panchkula is directed to decide the legal notice cum representation dated 20.01.2026 (Annexures P-20), after providing opportunity of hearing to the petitioners and by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from today, and a copy of the said speaking order shall be supplied to the petitioners within one week thereafter.

6. The petition in the aforesaid terms stands disposed off.
