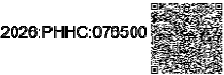

The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the memorandum dated 07.01.2026, Annexure P-13, containing the statement of allegations and charges against the petitioner.

2. On 24.04.2026, learned State counsel contended that the Department was unable to take further action on the chargesheet issued vide the impugned memorandum, since the reply submitted thereto by the petitioner dated 27.01.2026, was unsigned. Learned senior counsel for the petitioner, accordingly, handed over a signed copy of the reply dated 02.04.2026, to learned State counsel on the last date of hearing, i.e., 28.04.2026.



3. Learned State counsel has received instructions from Director, Secondary Education, vide memo dated 13.05.2026, which is retained on the case file as Annexure ‘A’. Referring the same, she submits that after considering the petitioner’s reply, an enquiry officer has been appointed to enquire into the charges of misconduct against the petitioner and he has been asked to appear before the officer.
4. In the light of these facts, learned senior counsel has no objection to the petition being disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to raise all appropriate pleas during the disciplinary enquiry.
5. Ordered accordingly.
