The appeal is disposed of with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.12,20,000/-in the name of appellant(s) with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within six

of this order till payment shall follow on the said amount. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt to learned counsel/representative of the Insurance Company after receiving the cheque. The learned counsel for the appellant(s) or appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

All interim application/s also stand/s disposed of.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
