The prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent Nos.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos. 6 to 8.

The counsel for the petitioners contends that the mobile phone of the petitioner No.2 was snatched by respondent No.6 who happens to be his father. The said mobile phone has not been returned. Therefore, protection be provided to the petitioners.

The counsel for the State has filed a reply dated 08.05.2025. While referring to the said reply, he contends that the dispute is between the families inasmuch as petitioner No.2 is the son of respondent No.6. Two

FIRs have already stand resgistered against the petitioners. The petitioners do not require any protection.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The present petition is an absolutely frivolous petition with a view to pressurize the private respondents out of which respondent No.6 is the father of petitioner No.2. In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed with the directions to the petitioners to deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- each with Spinal Rehab Centre, Chandigarh, Plot No.1, Madhya Marg, Sector-28A, Chandigarh, 0172-4610311 within a period of one week.

In case, the said amounts are not been deposited within a period of one week, the movable/immovable property of the petitioners to the extent of Rs.40,000/- be attached till the said amount is deposited. Copy of this order be sent to SSP, Jalandhar for further necessary action.
