1. In the present writ petition, the petitioners have challenged the public notice dated 24.02.2026 (Annexure P-3) issued by the Director, SCERT, Punjab proposing to conduct a Special TET Examination exclusively for those candidates, who were promoted vide letters dated 12.11.2025, 24.12.2025, 24.12.2025, 04.01.2026 and 05.01.2026.
2. The learned State counsel submits that the Government has in fact taken a decision to withdraw the abovesaid public notice. As such, the present writ petition is rendered infructuous.
3. In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as having rendered infructuous.
