This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay the difference of salary as being paid to the employees, who are juniors to the petitioners.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 31.07.2024 (Annexure P-7) within a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Vikram Bajaj, Sr. Panel Counsel, having been served with an advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent - UOI and assures the Court that representation dated 31.07.2024 (Annexure P-7) shall be decided by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.

5. In view of the above, and without adverting to the merits of the



case, the respondent No.2-Chief Executive Officer, Cantonment Board, Ambala, is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 31.074.2024 (Annexure P-7) after providing opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within seven days thereafter.

7. Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
