1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner for directions to the respondent No.2 to restrain the respondent No.4 from causing the harassment to the petitioner by calling him in his office again and again on the pretext to conduct the inquiry in the fresh complaint given by the private respondents against the petitioner.

2. The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the petitioner has filed the representation dated 16.02.2026 (Annexure P-3) before the respondent No.2-the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana. The learned counsel prays for disposing of the present petition by issuing directions to the respondent No.2 to decide the above-mentioned representation within a stipulated time.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Since advance notice has already been served upon the State, Mr. I.P.S. Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Hence, the service of notice upon the State is hereby dispensed with.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2-the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana or, on assignment by him, by any other police officer not below the rank of Deputy Commissioner of Police to decide the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-3), by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of instant order. It is however clarified that no finding is being returned, by this Court, with regard to merits of the contents of representation. The respondent No.2 shall be at liberty to make an independent assessment with regard to contents of representation of the petitioner and take an independent decision at his own level.
