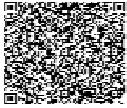

1. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that a perusal of the order dated 05.05.2025 would show that it had been directed that the legal notice of the petitioner be decided and the amount found due be disbursed. It is submitted that the entire amount due as per the respondents has been paid to the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that no interest has been awarded to which the learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that there was no specific direction to grant interest.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the said circumstances, the present petition be disposed of but liberty be granted to the petitioner to institute appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law, for the redressal of the grievances if any left.
4. In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.
5. It would be open to both the parties to raise all pleas in case any such proceeding is instituted by the petitioner.
