1. None is present for the appellant. On the previous date, counsel appearing for the Bank submitted that Mr. O.P. Goyal, previous counsel for the appellant is unable to put appearance before the Court. So, notice was issued to the appellant-bank. Notice has been received back duly served through Manager but none has come present. It seems that appellant is not interested in pursuing the appeal.
