1. This revision petition has been instituted under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is for setting aside the impugned order dated 17.02.2026 (Annexure P-7) passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Kaithal in Execution Petition No.EXE/78/2022, vide which the application dated 14.02.2025 (Annexure P-6) filed by the petitioner for staying the execution proceedings during the pendency of the application (Annexure P-4) under Order 9 Rule 13 CPC for setting aside the ex parte decree has been dismissed.

2. Mr. Ajay Gupta, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent and filed his power of attorney, which is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.



3. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the material on record.
4. After hearing both the parties, it has been agreed that petitioner will deposit 50% of the decretal amount along with proportionate interest within one month from today and he will furnish bank guarantee in respect of the balance amount before the Executing Court and in case, he complies with the undertaking given today in the Court, the execution of the ex parte judgment and decree dated 17.02.2026 shall remain stayed till decision of the application under Order 9 Rule 13 of CPC.
5. Accordingly, the present revision petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
6. Pending misc application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
