The present application has been filed under Order XXII Rule 3 read with Section 151 of CPC for bringing on record the LR of the deceased appellant-Surinder Singh, who died on 10.02.2025 during the pendency of the appeal. Copy of his death certificate is annexed as Annexure A-1. The proposed LR is the only son of deceased appellant. Application is duly supported with an affidavit of Rajvinder Singh Randhawa, son of deceased appellant-Surinder Singh.

In view of the contents of the application, the same is allowed and LR of deceased appellant is brought on record. Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

The present application has been filed under Order XXIII Rule 3 read with Section 151 of CPC for withdrawal of the appeal. The application

has been filed on the ground that parties have entered into compromise dated 19.03.2026, copy of which is Annexure A-2 and in view of the compromise, applicant does not want to pursue with the instant appeal and the same be dismissed as withdrawn.
