Main case:

The instant petition has been filed for quashing of FIR bearing No.355 dated 16.12.2024 registered under Sections 125, 109, 3(5) of the

Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) alongwith all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 07.03.2025 (Annexure P-2).

Vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No.2 has been filed today in the Court and the same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place with page marking.

On being confronted with the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter of '*Gulab Das Vs. State of M.P.*' reported as **2011 (10) SCC 765** and the fact that there is attribution of three shots being fired by the petitioners on the respondent-complainant, counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of the present petition.
