The present Regular Second Appeal has been filed by the appellants/defendants against the judgment and decree dated 23.10.2001 passed by learned Additional District Judge, Narnaul (hereinafter to be referred as 'Lower Appellate Court') whereby the appeal filed by the respondent-plaintiff against the judgment and decree dated 09.11.1998 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Narnaul (hereinafter to be referred as 'trial Court') was allowed and it was held that the respondent/plaintiff would be deemed to be in service as Octroi Inspector, as no order of reversion has ever been passed. The respondent/plaintiff was also held entitled to the pay-scale of Octroi Inspector w.e.f. 12.06.1996 when approval was accorded by the Deputy



Commissioner to appoint/promote the respondent/plaintiff on the post of Octroi Inspector.

2. The present appeal was admitted vide order dated 01.08.2003, however, there was no stay on the judgment and decree dated 23.10.2001 passed by the Lower Appellate Court.

3. Learned counsel for the appellants/defendants submits that the judgment and decree dated 23.10.2001 passed by the Lower Appellate Court has been executed during the pendency of the present appeal and the respondent/plaintiff also retired on attaining the age of superannuation on 28.02.2013.

4. In light of the abovesaid facts, learned counsel for the appellants/defendants submits that the present appeal has rendered infructuous and same may be disposed of accordingly.

5. In view of above, the present appeal is disposed of having rendered infructuous.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand(s) disposed of.
