1. None is present on behalf of the appellants. Appellants No.1 to 3 are reported to be dead. An application for impleading the LR's of appellants No.1 to 3 was required to be filed but no such application has been filed. It seems that LR's of the appellants are not interested in the matter.
2. In such circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the instant appeal on the docket, indefinitely.
3. Accordingly, the instant appeal stands dismissed for want of prosecution with liberty to the appellants to revive the same, if have any grievance from this order, within a period of three months from today.
4. As a natural corollary, since the main case stands dismissed for want of prosecution of, all pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of, as no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping them pending.
