The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to regularise the petitioners' services in view of the judgment passed by the Supreme Court in *Jaggo v. Union of India and others*, 2024 SCC Online SC 3826, and grant them all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case respondent no.3 is directed to decide their pending legal notice, dated 31.01.2026, Annexure P-12, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents, and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 31.01.2026, will be decided by respondent no.3-Director General, Higher Education, by passing a speaking order thereupon in accordance with law by taking into consideration the judgment in *Jaggo*



5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioners has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
6. Ordered accordingly.
7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioners.
