1. No one has put in appearance on behalf of the appellant today. On the previous date as well, none appeared on behalf of the appellant. Notices were issued to the appellant as well as learned counsel for the appellant. As per the office report, learned counsel for the appellant was informed of the date fixed vide letter No.860 dated 13.02.2026; however, he has not put in appearance despite informed. It is further noticed that notice to the appellant could not be issued for want of paper book, as the present case is a fully burnt case and no record is available with the Court.

2. In such circumstances, the appeal cannot be pursued any further and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the instant appeal on the docket, indefinitely.
