Petition herein is, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside the order dated 27.02.2018 (Annexure P-9) passed by the learned Collector, Khanna; order dated 11.12.2018 (Annexure P-11) passed by the learned Divisional Commissioner, Patiala; and order dated 16.07.2024 (Annexure P-12) passed by the learned Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab.

2. Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that certain relevant documents in support of the assertions made in the present writ petition have remained to be annexed, accordingly, he may be permitted to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to file fresh one with better particulars and after placing on record the sanctioned Mode of Partition, the

zimni orders passed by the learned Assistant Collector during the course of the partition proceedings, as well as the order of partition dated 28.12.2016.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned senior counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
