1. Learned counsel for the appellant states that the present case is covered against the appellant in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Union of India vs. Popular Construction Co., (2001) 8 SCC 470* and therefore an appropriate order may be passed.
2. A perusal of the impugned order shows that the objections were filed by the appellant under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, beyond the prescribed period i.e. beyond three months plus thirty days. At the preliminary hearing stage, the objections were dismissed in view of the aforesaid judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Union of India vs. Popular Construction Co. (supra)*.



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3. In view of the above, the present appeal is dismissed.
