SUBHAS MEHLA, J (ORAL)

1. The prayer in the instant criminal writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing official respondent(s) to take an appropriate action against private respondent(s), who are harassing and threatening the petitioners by interfering in their peaceful life and liberty.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr.Surinderjit Singh Nahar, AAG, Punjab, appears and accepted notice on behalf of respondent/State.

4. In this regard, this Court has already given the directions in **Asha and another vs. State of Haryana and others, CWP No.6717 of 2009 (2012 SCC Online P&H 12746)**, and in compliance of the same, the State Government had taken steps to protect the life and liberty of run away couple.

5. Apart from that the **State of Punjab** vide **notification dated 23.01.2025** also notified the SOPs for the protection of life and liberty of the



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petitioners in similar situations, in compliance of the *Criminal Writ Petition No.12562 of 2023* titled as “*Kajal Vs. State of Haryana and others*”.

6. In the light of the above directions, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, Punjab, to consider and take necessary action on the representation dated 10.03.2026 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law.
