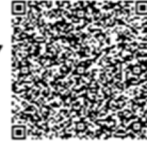

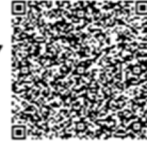

MANISHA BATRA, J (ORAL):-

The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short-‘BNSS’) for quashing of FIR No. 101 dated 19.07.2025 registered under Sections 61, 316(4), 318(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short ‘BNS’) at Police Station Barara, District Ambala and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 06.03.2026 (Annexure P-2).

2 . This Court vide order dated 16.03.2026 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

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3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ambala and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Judge has submitted report dated 08.05.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties were voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303***, this petition is allowed and FIR No. 101 dated 19.07.2025 registered under Sections 61, 316(4), 318(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNS') at Police Station Barara, District Ambala and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 06.03.2026 (Annexure P-2) are quashed qua the petitioners.
