MANDEEP PANNU, J. (Oral)

1. This petition is filed under Section 528 of the BNSS, 2023 (earlier Section 482 of the Cr.P.C.) seeking a direction restraining respondent No. 4 from unnecessarily harassing the petitioner, in violation of the instructions issued by the Director General of Police, Punjab, vide Memo No. 5742/CR-LA-4 dated 10.08.2022 (Annexure P-7), at the behest of respondent No. 5, who has exceeded his authority in matters where he has no jurisdiction.

2. Mr. Satvir Singh, Advocate, has made appearance on behalf of respondent No.5 and filed memo of appearance, which is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 06.03.2026 (Annexure P-8), and decide the same in accordance with law.

4. Without adverting to the merits of the case and in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, respondent No.2- Additional Director General of Police, Prisons, Punjab Prison Headquarter, SCO-8-9, Sector 17-A, Chandigarh is directed to look into the representation dated 06.03.2026 (Annexure P-8) in accordance with the instructions contained in Annexure P-7, and decide the same expeditiously in accordance with law.

5. The present petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
