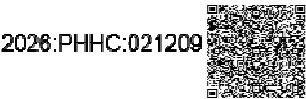
VIRINDER AGGARWAL, J. (Oral)

1. Counsel for the appellants submitted that appellants are not in touch with him. Notice was issued to the appellants, appellant No.2(ii), 2(iii) and (iv) are served. None appeared. This is an appeal arising out of suit for permanent injunction and pending since more than 25 years. So, it seems that appellants are not interested in pursuing the appeal and this appeal arises out of a suit for permanent injunction only.

2. In such circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the instant appeal on the docket, indefinitely.

3. Accordingly, the instant appeals RSA-3417-2000 and RSA-3418-2000 stands dismissed with liberty to the appellants to revive the same, if have any grievance from this order, within a period of three months from today.
