VIRINDER AGGARWAL, J. (Oral)

1. The report of field Kanungo of Nabha, District Patiala has not been received. Counsel for the appellant intimated that they could not contact the appellant in spite of repeated efforts and it is not possible to establish contact, so, the fee of the Local Commissioner could not be deposited. Considering, the fact that order passed by this Court on 13.11.2025 could not be complied with as the appellant is not approachable.

2. In such circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the instant appeal on the docket, indefinitely.

3. Accordingly, the instant appeal stands dismissed with liberty to the appellant to revive the same, if have any grievance from this order, within a period of three months from today.

4. As a natural corollary, since the main case stands dismissed for want of prosecution of, all pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of, as no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping them pending.
