The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant and release the benefit of first and second ACP to the petitioner from the date of his entitlement as per provisions of the Haryana Civil Services (Assured Career Progression) Rules, 2008/2016, along with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to decide his pending legal notice, dated 19.09.2025, Annexure P-9, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents, and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 19.09.2025, will be decided by respondent no.2-Director, Secondary Education, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within three months.



- 5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
- 6. Ordered accordingly.
- 7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
