1. Neither the appellant nor the respondents are appearing, either through their counsel or in person. Notices were ordered to be issued to both parties. As per the service report, the sole appellant has since died; however, none has come forward on his behalf. Similarly, respondents No. 1 and 3 are stated to have died, but no legal representatives have been impleaded. Respondents No. 2 and 4 could not be served for want of correct addresses, and in the absence of the appellant, their correct addresses are not available.
2. In these circumstances, it appears that the legal representatives of the appellant are not interested in pursuing the present appeal. Accordingly, the present appeal is dismissed for non-prosecution, subject to liberty to the legal representatives of the appellant to get it revived by showing sufficient cause.
