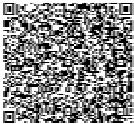

SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. The petitioner in this PIL has raised alleged public cause of non-supply of adequate and equitable LPG cylinders to the consumers in the State of Haryana.

1.1 Learned Additional Solicitor General of India, learned counsel for the State of Haryana and learned counsel for respondent No.3 – Indian Oil Corporation, who are appearing on advance copy, submit that there is no shortage of LPG cylinders in the State of Haryana and appropriate steps are



being taken to regulate the supply, distribution, storage and other related aspects of LPG ecosystem so as to prevent any disruption or imbalance.

2. In view of above, the petitioner is at liberty to approach the authorities by filing representation raising his grievance, which if filed, shall be considered and decided by the concerned authority by passing a speaking order and communicating the same to the petitioner, within a period of two weeks from the date of its filing.

3. Accordingly, petition stands disposed of.
