NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

The instant Regular Second Appeal has been preferred by the appellant/defendant-Punjab State Electricity Board against the judgments and decrees dated 17.02.1997 and 19.08.2000, passed by the learned Trial Court and the First Appellate Court respectively, whereby the suit filed by respondents No.1 and 2/plaintiff has been decreed and the appeal filed by the appellant/defendant has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for respondents No.1 and 2/plaintiffs submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get instructions from respondents No.1 and 2.

Learned counsel for the appellant/PSEB (now PSPCL) submits that respondent No.1-Balbir Singh and respondent No.2-Dasaundhra Singh have retired from service on 31.12.2023 and 31.12.2019, respectively. revive the appeal, in case, respondents No.1 and 2 approaches the concerned department for implementation of the judgments and decrees of the learned Trial Court and the First Appellate Court.

4. In view of the above, the present appeal is disposed of at this stage with aforesaid liberty.
