The prayer in the petition under Section 482 of BNSS is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case registered against him vide FIR No.0658 dated 11.11.2025 under Sections 316(2), 316(5), 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 61, 3(5) and 344 of BNS, 2023 and Sections 7 and 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 PS Assandh, District Karnal.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 10.04.2026 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of order dated 10.04.2026 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 10.04.2026 is

made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) Cr.P.C.
