1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for quashing of the Complaint No.12406 of 2018 dated 12.09.2018 (Annexure P-1) filed by respondent No.1, under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, against the petitioner.
2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner relates to disputed questions of liability, which are to be adjudicated at trial. The further contention, whether the complainant is engaged in the business of money-lending without a valid licence, shall likewise be determined at the appropriate stage of the proceedings.
3. Hence, this Court finds no merit in the contention raised by learned counsel for the petitioner, accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
