The present application has been filed under Section 151 of Code of Civil Procedure to place on record the copies of death certificates of appellant-Bhagwan Dass and one of his legal heirs-Pardeep Kumar, copies of death certificate of respondent-Madan Lal and his wife-Parvishta Devi and for exemption from filing the certified and typed copies of the annexures.

In view of the contents of the application, the same is allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

CM-3472-C-2026

The instant application has been filed under Order 22 Rule 3 read with Section 151 of CPC for impleading the LRs of appellant-Bhagwan Dass, who died during the pendency of the appeal. Death certificate of deceased appellant is annexed as Annexure A-1. The proposed LRs are wife of deceased appellant-Bhagwan Dass, husband and children of pre-deceased daughter-Bindu Bala, wife and children of pre-deceased son-Pardeep Kumar, and son-Hardeep Kumar. One of the LRs namely Sagar Suman and another Inderjit



Kumar Gangar has not joined in moving the application as they are residing abroad, so, they are added as proforma respondents. Application is duly supported by an affidavit of Hardeep Kumar, son of deceased appellant-Bhagwan Dass.

In view of the reasons stated in the application and supporting affidavit, the same is allowed. Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

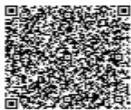
CM-3473-C-2026

The instant application has been filed under Order 22 Rule 4 read with Section 151 of CPC for impleading the LR's of respondent-Madan Lal, who died on 26.11.2009. Death certificate of deceased respondent is annexed as Annexure A-3. Wife of deceased respondent-Parvishta Devi has also died and copy of her death certificate is annexed as Annexure A-4. The proposed LR's are children of deceased respondent-Madan Lal. Application is duly supported by an affidavit of Hardeep Kumar.

In view of the reasons stated in the application and supporting affidavit, the same is allowed. Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

CM-3474-C-2026

The present application has been filed under Section 151 of CPC with a prayer that appeal be decided in view of the compromise dated 10.03.2026 effected between the parties and copy of the same has been placed on record as Annexure P5. The application is duly supported with an affidavit of Hardeep Kumar. The matter has been compromised and it is settled that a sum of Rs.2,80,000/- as full and final settlement of the claim of the plaintiff-Madan Lal be paid to his sons-Rajeev Kumar, Sanjeev Kumar. His daughter-Anjna Pandhi has given up her claim with regard to this litigation. The



agreement is duly signed by all the LR's of the appellant and respondent-Madan Lal. All three LR's of Madan Lal namely Rajeev Kumar, Sanjeev kumar, Anjna Pandhi are signatory to this compromise (Annexure P5).

In view of the averments made in the application, the same is allowed.

Main case (O&M)

Mr. Lovish Rattan, Advocate, has appeared on behalf of respondents No.1 (i), (ii) and (iii) and filed his power of attorney, which is taken on record.

In view of the order passed in CM-3474-C-2026, this regular second appeal is disposed of in view of the compromise effected between the parties and compromise deed (Annexure P-5) will form part of the decree.

Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, are also disposed of.
