The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the benefit of additional ten per cent of basic pay with dearness allowance to the petitioner in terms of para 10 of Teacher Transfer Policy, 2025, Annexure P-1. The petitioner is statedly serving as PRT/JBT Teacher at Government Primary School, Adbar, Block Nuh, Mewat, for the last ten years.

2. Learned State counsel has received instructions from the fourth respondent vide memo dated 16.04.2026, a copy whereof is retained on the case file as Annexure 'A'. Referring to the same, she contends that the petitioner is an employee of the Mewat cadre, and has been placed at number 495 in the seniority list of JBT Teachers of the cadre issued on 21.03.2022.

3. It remains undisputed that the benefit of additional ten per cent of basic pay in terms of the Policy is admissible to the teachers who do not belong to the Mewat cadre, but have been transferred there. Accordingly, there is no ground to entertain the petition, and it stands dismissed.
