1. Present second petition has been filed under Section 483 of the BNSS for seeking regular bail in case arising out of FIR No.44 dated 22.10.2023, registered under Sections 21, 25 and 29 of NDPS Act, 1985 {Section 18 of NDPS Act, 1985, Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 and Section 473 of IPC (341(2) of BNS, 2023) added later on), at Police Station State Special Operation Cell (SSOC), District Intelligence Wing (CID), Amritsar.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition, at this stage.
3. Ordered accordingly.
4. During the course of hearing, it is, however, pointed out that one of the co-accused, namely, Maninder Singh was granted interim bail on account of kidney transplantation of his wife. After having been released on interim bail, he absconded and has not joined the proceedings thereafter.



5. Let the Assistant Inspector General, State Special Operation Cell (SSOC), Amritsar apprise this Court as to what steps have been taken to ensure arrest of the absconding co-accused in a matter where huge quantity of contraband i.e. 12 kgs, 430 gms of heroin, 23 kgs, 300 gms of opium, 1 pistol 30 bore alongwith magazine and five live cartridges 30 bore had been recovered from the accused persons.

6. He shall join the proceedings through **Video Conferencing** mode.
