1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 (Section 482 of Cr.P.C.) praying for issuance of appropriate direction to the respondent authorities to conduct free and fair investigation in FIR No.0066 dated 06.10.2025 registered under Section 85 and 316(2) of BNS (erstwhile Section 498-A and 406 IPC) registered at Women Police Station, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1). A further prayer has also been made for issuance of direction to respondents to investigate the role of the other accused persons, who have been specifically named in the complaint but have not been arrayed as accused in the FIR, in order to ensure a fair, impartial and complete investigation. A further prayer has also been made for issuance of direction to the respondent authorities to decide the representations dated 21.10.2025 (Annexure P-3 to P-5) submitted by the petitioner before the concerned authorities.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 21.10.2025 (Annexure P-3) to Senior Superintendent of Police, Police Headquarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh raising his grievances as raised in the present petition but no action has been taken so far. He further submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied, if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.4- Senior Superintendent of Police, Police Headquarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh to decide the representation dated 21.10.2025 (Annexure P-3), in a time bound manner and take necessary action.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Rahul Arora, Addl. P.P., U.T, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 5-U.T. and submits that needful shall be done in due course. Let a complete set of paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

5. Without adverting to the merits of the case and in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, respondent No.4- Superintendent of Police, Police Headquarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh is directed to look into the representation 21.10.2025 (Annexure P-3), and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

6. The present petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
