VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J (ORAL)

The instant revision petition, preferred under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, assails the order dated 10.03.2026 passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Mansa (executing Court), vide which the salary of the Managing Director of the petitioner-corporation had been attached and he had been called upon to submit a detailed affidavit reflecting the property of the petitioner-corporation.

2. On 23.04.2026, a coordinate Bench passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the Auditors of the petitioner-corporation shall sit with the respondents-decree holders on Friday i.e. 27.03.2026, so as to find out the amount due, which shall be released in favour of the decree-holders at the earliest.

Notice of motion for 07.04.2026.

Liberty is granted to serve the respondents through their counsel before the learned Executing Court.

In the meanwhile, learned Executing Court is requested to permit the Managing Director of Pepsu Road Transport Corporation to join the proceedings through video-conferencing.

To be shown in the urgent cause list, henceforth.”

3. Today, learned counsel representing respondents No.1 to 3/claimants submits that pursuant to the order dated 24.03.2026 having been passed, the salary of the Managing Director of the petitioner-corporation has been released and he had also caused appearance before the executing Court and an unconditional apology was tendered by him, which was accepted. Learned counsel has produced a copy of order dated 27.03.2026 passed by the executing Court, which is taken on record. In fact, a cheque for the part decretal amount was also deposited before the executing Court.

4. That being so, nothing survives in the instant revision petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.

Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
