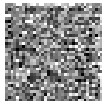

SUDEEPTI SHARMA, J. (Oral)

1. The contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 14.11.2023 passed in CWP-15015-2023.
2. Learned counsel for respondent contends that in compliance of order dated 14.11.2023, affidavit of Mr. Ashok Kaushik, General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Chandigarh dated 18.09.2025 along with Annexure R-1 has been filed. Copy of the same is taken on record.
3. A perusal of affidavit dated 18.09.2025 shows that respondents have challenged order dated 14.11.2023 passed in CWP-15015-2023 before Hon'ble Supreme Court and the Hon'ble Supreme Court has granted stay vide order dated 11.11.2024.
4. In view of the same, the contempt is dismissed.
5. Needless to say that liberty is however granted to the petitioners to avail the remedy as is available to them after the decision of Special Leave to Appeal (C) No(s).25919/2024.
6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
