JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to release payment with respect to work carried out by it for the respondent along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned State counsel submits that competent authority would consider petitioner's claim and if any admitted liability is found, it would be discharged within 3 months from today.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent may be subjected to interest @ 6% per annum.

4. In the wake of statement of both sides, the petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondents to release payment to the petitioner within 3 months from today. If payment is not released within aforesaid period, the respondent would be liable to pay interest @ 9% from



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the expiry of said period. The petitioner is at liberty to approach appropriate authority *qua* disputed amount, if any.
