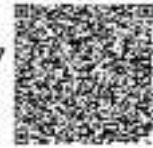

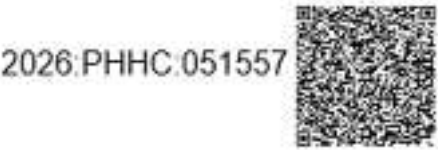

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the official respondents No. 2 to 6 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No. 7 to 10 and to take legal action against them.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have recently filed a representation on 07.03.2026 before respondent No.6-SHO, Police Station Tigaon, District Faridabad raising their grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Faridabad to ensure that the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioners is decided and necessary action thereon is taken against the private respondents.

3. Notice of motion.



4. Ms. Himani Arora, DAG, Haryana, has advance notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paper-book be supplied to her during the course of the day.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioners, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 3-Commissioner of Police, Faridabad to ensure that the aforesaid representation dated 07.03.2026 (Annexure P-2) is decided within a period of one month from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law. Needless to say, if any threat is found to the petitioners, the official respondents would provide them adequate security in order to protect their life and liberty.
