(1) This petition has been preferred to challenge show cause notice dated 06.08.2025 on the ground that along with the show cause notice no supportive documents have been appended.

(2) At the outset, learned counsel for the respondent(s) submits that at the time of personal hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner was not only handed over all the supportive documents but he has also been granted time to respond to the same.

(3) Learned counsel for the petitioner does not deny the above fact and in the light of such development, seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to pursue the show cause notice with the respondent-authorities.

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(4) Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
