1. Present second petition has been filed praying for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.0159, dated 24.08.2020, under Sections 307, 353, 332, 333, 186, 34 of IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act (Sections 473, 212, 216, 120-B IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is behind bars since 24.08.2020.
3. However learned counsel for the State, at the outset, has submitted that all the prosecution witnesses have already been examined and the case is now fixed for defence evidence. He thus, submits that the trial is at the fag end.
