The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the order dated 30.11.1998, whereby the petitioner was retired from service. His claim is that retirement was premature as his date of birth was incorrectly recorded as 02.11.1940, instead of 02.11.1944. And on that basis he was entitled to remain in service upto 30.11.2002.

2. Learned State counsel contends that in the service record, the petitioner's date of birth is mentioned as 02.11.1940, which is substantiated from his matriculation certificate, dated 20.05.1958, Annexure R-1 also. Accordingly, he attained the age of superannuation, i.e., fifty-eight years on 01.11.1998, and was retired from service at the end of the month on 30.11.1998.

3. These assertions have not been disputed by the petitioner by filing any counter-affidavit, nor has he placed any document on record to establish that his date of birth is 02.11.1944.



4. In view thereof, there is no ground to entertain the petition and it stands dismissed.
5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stand(s) disposed of.
